

Rules for the election of the representatives of Registrars within the advisory Steering Committee of the Registro .it

Version 2.1

April 2024

Introduction

The Registro .it is administered by the Institute of Informatics and Telematics of the CNR (IIT) on the basis of appropriate delegation issued in 1987 by the IANA/ICANN (<http://www.iana.org>), formalized in a separate written agreement.

The Registrar is an organization accredited by the Registro .it and as such can manage in person and through its organization, services of registration and maintenance of domain names in the ccTLD .it in synchronous mode to the conditions set out in this agreement and in accordance with Regulations of the ccTLD .it.

The system of assigning domain names on the Internet is configured on the basis of international technical protocols needed to maintain balance and functionality of the system.

The Registro .it relies on the Steering Committee (hereafter CIR), previously referred to as Rules Committee, since 2004, in an advisory capacity, for the preparation of the rules concerning the operation of the Registry. 4 (four) representatives of the Registrars, indicated by the most representative organizations, are part of the CIR. There are, on the date of publication of this Regulation, about 1,200 contracts held by Registrars.

It is necessary to ensure the widest participation and opportunity to represent all Registrars, in accordance with the procedures adopted by major international organizations such as RIPE-NCC, CENTR, ICANN, and in some ccTLD registries.

On the basis of the requests made by CIR, it emerged that a different method of representation of the Registrar organisations was necessary, either on an elective basis or by direct appointment by the associations representing the Registrars. The discussion on this subject therefore led to the determination of assigning to the Registrar associations two places in the CIR, leaving the allocation of the remaining two to the outcome of a specific elective procedure by the Registrars holding a contract with the Registry, on the basis of the assumptions, conditions and terms specified below.

For all of the above, the Registro .it issues the following regulations for the election of 2 (two) representatives of the Registrars as regards the CIR of Registro .it.

Art. 1 Election eligibility

All Registrar organizations, which, at the date of the election procedure of Representatives, hold a contract signed directly between the .it Registry and the Registrar and have passed the technical accreditation procedure, can take part in elections.

The Registrars, belonging to the two associations of operators of the sector whose representative sits on the CIR may participate in the election process only as voters but not as candidates.

Art. 2 Mechanism for the election of Registrars representatives

The Registro .it activates the mechanism of election by officially opening the period dedicated to the receipt of applications, with expressed communication addressed to all Registrars and on the RAIN-NG portal (<https://rain.nic.it>).

In order to allow the elections of the representatives of the Registrars within the CIR, the Registro .it provides an automated technological platform for voting (<https://elections-cir.nic.it>), in the ways and conditions set out in the following.

CANDIDACY PHASE

The period of “**candidacy**” has a term of 15 (fifteen) days.

Preliminarily, the Registrar must authenticate on the voting portal using the credentials associated to the Registrar tag or with another user having the “admin” role (the voting portal is also accessible through RAIN-NG by accessing the menu item "Election of CIR Representatives") and access the appropriate item in order to create a user with the role of "candidate".

The “candidate” must belong to the Registrar organization.

The candidate, after having received by the Registrar the credentials to access the voting portal, must authenticate on the portal, confirm and/or update his/her data and indicate his/her election program. He/she must also attach a CV that describes the skills and experiences in the field; grant consent to the publication of personal data and information that will be announced to the Registrars participating in the voting procedure, through publication on the RAIN-NG portal; declare to belong to the Registrar organization. The CV must not contain sensitive data.

ENDORSEMENT PHASE

This phase occurs only if at least 1 (one) candidate is present.

After the nomination period, the Registry publishes on the voting portal the list of candidates who are standing for election and subsequently opens a period of “**endorsement**”, which has a duration of 10 (ten) days.

The period of endorsement includes the following steps:

- the Registrar must authenticate on the voting portal using the credentials associated to the Registrar tag or with another user having the “admin” role, and display the candidates that are standing for election and the information made available;
- each Registrar can express from 0 (zero) to a maximum of 5 (five) *endorsements* to support candidates who intend to bring to the final election stage. The *endorsements* will be published anonymously.

The system does not allow a Registrar to give more endorsements to the same candidate and to give the endorsement to a candidate belonging to his/her Registrar organization.

When the period of endorsement is finished, the Registro .it publishes on the voting portal the list of candidates ordered, in a decreasing number of endorsements received, duly anonymized.

The first 20 candidates who have received a number of endorsements greater than 0 (zero), will be considered eligible. In the event that, in the 20th position there are several candidates having the same number of votes, they will all access the final voting phase.

The candidates, who progress to the final vote, and their curricula, will be published on the voting portal.

Art. 3 Voting procedures

The final vote takes place online, via the electronic platform made available to the Registrars by the Registro .it.

The procedure of final vote takes place, following the completion of the procedure of endorsement, on a day set by the Registro .it. It lasts 3 (three) days: it starts at 9:00 am (local time) of the first day and ends at 19 (local time) of the third day.

Voting is carried out by the Registrars on the voting portal <https://elections-cir.nic.it>.

Each Registrar may cast only one vote. The vote can be casted also in favour of the candidate belonging to his/her Registrar organization.

Art. 4 Process of vote counting

When the period of the final vote is finished, the electronic voting system automatically performs the count and publishes the list of candidates, ranked according to decreasing number of votes received.

Art. 5 Registrar representatives elected and appointed in the CIR

To be eligible for election, a candidate must have received at least 1 (one) vote.

The first 2 (two) representatives of Registrars who obtained the highest number of votes are elected.

They are nominated in the CIR by decision of the Director of the Institute for Informatics and Telematics of the CNR.

The vote is valid regardless of the number of voters and Registrar candidates.

Where, at the end of the elective procedure, it appears that only one candidate has received votes, the vote is considered valid for the purposes of the composition of the advisory Steering Committee of the Registry.

In the event that the election ends without a winner (the endorsement phase was not started due to the absence of potential candidates, or none of the candidates received votes), the voting procedure will be repeated once.

If there is a tie vote between two or more elected candidates the youngest prevails.

In the event of any resignation by one of the elected representatives, or in the event that the Registrar organization loses its quality, the first of the non-elected in the ranking will take over, until the ranking is exhausted.
